

THE RULES FOR FOUR-MAN CHESS

1. All four kings should stand to the left of the queen.
2. The game proceeds in clockwise order.
3. The player choosing the lightest colour out of the bag will move first.
4. All pieces move the same way as in normal chess.
5. If a pawn has reached the base line of any of his opponents, he may choose a piece of his choice to promote the pawn.
6. En-passant is only used against players from directly opposite and not against the players on the left or right sides.
7. Castling is done exactly the same as normal chess.
8. A player in check-mate may be helped by another opponent if such decides he would prefer the check-mate player to stay in the game; he may block or remove the piece check-mating the opponent; if no-one helps the player in check-mate, he must remove all the pieces from the board.
9. The last player with pieces on the board will be the winner of the game.
