Parking

Access to our classes is from the large car park off Lower Tygerbergvalley Road or from the Grade R parking area at the Voortrekker Hall. Please ensure that the gate is always closed behind you. Driving into the school grounds is not permitted.

Parent Information Evening

An information meeting for all parents will be held early in the new year. It is essential that at least one parent of each learner attends. This will be an opportunity to familiarize yourselves with the policies and procedures in our Pre-Grade R department.

Please send the following items to school with your child on the first day of school:

- A rigid plastic suitcase, A3 size is required. Bags, rucksacks and pull-along cases are not allowed.
- Please cover the message book with attractive paper. Glue the supplied label onto the front of the book - in the top left hand corner - then cover the book with contact.
- A change of clothing in case of spills: a set of old clothes in a zip-lock type bag and clearly marked. Please remember to replace clothes used and substitute for change of seasons.
- A healthy tea time snack.
- Please send 2 containers liquid hand soap and 1 box of tissues.
- Please send a clearly marked sun hat that can be left at school.
- Apply sunblock before coming to school, please.

Please mark all personal articles clearly with your child's name and surname.

Class requirements/baking

Your school account will be debited with R65,00 on 1 March and 1 August respectively, to cover the cost of class requirements for Pre-Grade R. All items will be kept at school.

T-Shirts

T-shirts are available from the school shop. We urge you to purchase t-shirts as our children wear them as a "uniform" on outings, as well as on Phys. Ed. days (Wednesdays).

Snack time

Please remember that this is a tea-time snack and not a main lunch. The emphasis is on teaching healthy eating habits.

We suggest sandwiches, plain Marie or Tennis biscuits, bran muffins, fresh fruit and vegetables, nuts, cheese, Vienna's, biltong or dried fruit.

The following are not allowed:

- Cakes, chips and sweets (Super C's included)
- Fizzy drinks or fizzy flavoured water
- Sweet treats and chips allowed after the healthy snack, on Fridays only!

Other requirements:

- Theme related stories and items are always welcome, as too are children's music and story CD's. Please, NO toys are to be brought to school.
- "Bare foot is best!" If, however, your child needs to wear something to school, please ensure that he or she wears sandals, slip-slops or Wellington boots.
- Wellington boots are compulsory for wet and cold weather.

Rules

- No personal toys.
- Boys - short, neat hairstyles suitable for school. No fringes below the eyebrows
Girls - hair tied up into ponytail or plait. No fringes below the eyebrows. Clips and hairbands must be used for short hair.
- Girls may only wear stud earrings. (No earrings that can hook onto clothing etc.)
- We suggest brown bread sandwiches, bran muffins, fresh fruit & vegetables, popcorn, nuts, cheese, Vienna's, biltong or dried fruit. Sweets, biscuits, chips, etc. only on Fridays.
- No medicine may be administered at school without written permission.
- Cash must always be placed in a marked envelope and dropped in the class post box.
- Please only park in the parking bays - do not ignore yellow or red traffic lines.
- Please always report to the office first, should you visit the school during school hours.
- Children may not leave school during the school day to attend extra mural activities elsewhere.
- Please do not ring the bell for early entry (before 07:30 or 12:30).
- Always close the gates behind you, please.
- Be punctual.
- We kindly request that parents vacate the school grounds as soon as possible after school, to accommodate the ASC and extra-mural activities. Please make use of the memorial garden (next to the primary school's main entrance) should you arrive early to collect your child from an extra-mural activity.
- Regrettably no dogs - big or small - are allowed on school grounds, please.
- The school is a smoke free zone. No smoking is therefore allowed on school property.
- You may only place photos of your own child on social media.
