Class requirements/baking

Your school account will be debited with R150,00 on 1 March and 1 August respectively, to cover the cost of class requirements for Grade R. All items will be kept at school.

T-Shirts

T-shirts are available from the school shop. We urge you to purchase t-shirts as our children wear them as a "uniform" on outings, as well as on Phys. Ed. Days (Thursdays).

Please send the following items to school with your child on the first day of school:

- A school bag a rigid plastic or cardboard suitcase (it must fit in a 30cm X 30cm locker)
- An art apron - **dad's old t-shirt** works well. Please attach a large loop at the neck so that it can easily be hung up. Write your child's **name** clearly on the front.
- 2 containers liquid hand soap.
- 2 x 40g Pritt
- 1 box of tissues.
- A clearly marked sun hat to be kept at school.

Please mark all personal articles clearly with your child's name and surname.

Rules

- No personal toys.
- Boys - short, neat hairstyles suitable for school. No fringe below eyebrows
Girls - hair tied up into ponytail or plait. No fringe below eyebrows. Clips and hairbands must be used for short hair.
- Girls may only wear stud earrings. (No earrings that can hook onto clothing etc.)
- We suggest brown bread sandwiches, bran muffins, fresh fruit & vegetables, popcorn, nuts, cheese, Vienna's, biltong or dried fruit. Sweets, biscuits, chips, etc. only on Fridays.
- No medicine may be administered at school without written permission.
- Cash must always be placed in a marked envelope and dropped in the class post box.
- Please only park in the parking bays - do not ignore yellow or red traffic lines.
- Please always report to the office first, should you visit the school during school hours.
- Children may not leave school during the school day to attend extra mural activities elsewhere.
- Please do not ring the bell for early entry (before 07:30 or 12:30).

- Always close the gates behind you, please.
- Be punctual.
- We kindly request that parents vacate the school grounds as soon as possible after school, to accommodate the ASC and extra-mural activities. Please make use of the memorial garden (next to the primary school's main entrance) should you arrive early to collect your child from an extra-mural activity.
- Regrettably no dogs - big or small - are allowed on school grounds, please.
- The school is a smoke free zone. No smoking is therefore allowed on school property, please.
- You may only place photos of your own child on social media.
