

HOMEWORK POLICY GRADE 6

A maximum of 45 minutes must be spent on written homework and a further 30 minutes must be devoted to studying.

- The learner who has not applied him/herself in class, been out for music, been absent or late, will have to complete work at home. (This will be in addition to the stipulated homework time).
- 2. At least 7 days notice will be given for Oral or Mondeling.
- 3. Rubrics for various assessment tasks will be given to learners when the specific task is introduced.
- 4. Research materials will be looked for at the library or at home. NO written tasks concerning the research is to be done at home.
- 5. Learners will be notified of dates of assessments on the grade term planner.
- 6. Learners must prepare themselves for the following school day. Organising books, art shirts, P.E. togs, sport equipment and stationery must be done in the evening.
- 7. Homework books must be signed daily by a parent/guardian. If the learner attends aftercare, the homework book must still be signed by a parent/guardian. A short note must be written if homework is incomplete or if books were left at school.
- 8. Correspondence between educator and parent can be written in the homework book or be sent via email. If confidential, this too can be emailed or placed in sealed envelope, marked attention for the teacher, with an indication in the homework book that a letter has been sent to school.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT GRADE 6 LEARNERS BE ENCOURAGED TO DEVELOP INDEPENDENCE AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR OWN WORK. PARENTAL GUIDANCE IS IMPORTANT.
