



HOMWORK POLICY GRADE 7

A maximum of 1hr 30 min should be spent on daily homework/studying with the exception of exam/scheduled term tests or projects.

1. The learner who has not applied him/herself in class, been out for music, been absent or late, will have to complete work at home. **(This will be in addition to the stipulated homework time)**. Learners will be notified of dates of assessments on the grade term planner.
2. Sufficient notice will be given for Orals, Mondelinge and tasks.
3. Rubrics containing information regarding the various assessment tasks will be given to learners once the tasks have been discussed.
4. Research tasks must be researched at the library or at home.
At times, Grade 7 learners will be required to complete tasks at home.
5. Learners will be notified of dates of assessments on the grade term planner.
6. Preparation for the following day should be done the night before, eg. organising of books, art shirts, P.E. togs, sport and stationery.
7. Learners must write homework down in a homework diary. Diaries should be checked by the parents on a regular basis. Grade 7 educators do not check homework diaries as subject teaching takes place.
8. All correspondence between the educator and the parent will be via the effective e-mail/sms systems at Kenridge Primary.

IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT GRADE 7 LEARNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE AND ACCOUNTABLE FOR THEIR WORK. PARENTAL GUIDANCE STILL REMAINS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THEIR DEVELOPMENT.
