Class requirements/baking

Your school account will be debited with R150,00 on 1 March and 1 August respectively, to cover the cost of class requirements for Grade R. All items will be kept at school.

T-Shirts

T-shirts are available from the school shop. We urge you to purchase t-shirts as our children wear them as a "uniform" on special occasions, as well as on Phys. Ed. Days (Thursdays).

Please send the following items to school with your child on the first day of school:

- A school bag a rigid plastic or cardboard suitcase (it must fit in a 30cm X 30cm locker)
- 2 containers liquid hand soap.
- 1 box of tissues.
- 1 pack wet wipes
- 2 x 40g Pritt
- A clearly marked sun hat
- An art shirt will be supplied by the school.

Please mark all personal articles clearly with your child's name and surname.

Snack time

Please remember that this is a tea-time snack and not a main lunch. The emphasis is on teaching healthy eating habits.

We suggest sandwiches, plain Marie or Tennis biscuits, bran muffins, fresh fruit and vegetables, nuts, cheese, sausages, ham, biltong or dried fruit.

Please ensure that your child has a water bottle when you pack a fruit juice or milkshake.

For hygiene purposes there are no cups in our bathrooms. Learners are taught to use their water bottles during outside play and at Aftercare.

The following are not allowed:

- Cakes, chips and sweets (Super C's included)
- Fizzy drinks or fizzy flavoured water
- Sweet treats and chips allowed after the healthy snack, on Fridays only!

Other requirements:

- Theme related stories and items are always welcome, as too are children's music and story CD's. Please, NO toys are to be brought to school.
- "Bare foot is best!" If, however, your child needs to wear something to school, please ensure that he or she wears sandals, slip-slops or shoes without laces.
- Waterproof shoes are compulsory for wet and cold weather.

Rules

- No personal toys.
- Boys - short, neat hairstyles suitable for school. No fringe below eyebrows
Girls - hair tied up into ponytail or plait. No fringe below eyebrows. Clips and hairbands must be used for short hair.
- Girls may only wear stud earrings. (No earrings that can hook onto clothing etc.)
- We suggest brown bread sandwiches, bran muffins, fresh fruit & vegetables, popcorn, nuts, cheese, Vienna's, biltong or dried fruit. Sweets, biscuits, chips, etc. only on Fridays.
- Always ensure that your child has a water bottle at school, especially if you pack a fruit juice or a milkshake. For hygiene purposes, there are no cups available in the bathrooms. Learners are taught to fill their water bottles for use during outside play and at Aftercare.
- No medicine may be administered at school without written permission.
- Cash must always be placed in a marked envelope and dropped in the class post box.

- Please only park in the parking bays - do not ignore yellow or red traffic lines.
- You are welcome to use the parking for the disabled for a quick drop-and-go. Please contact the office should you need us to reserve the disabled parking for you.
- During school hours, access can only be gained via the main gate of the Pre-primary, at the Voortrekker Hall.
- Please always report to the office first, should you visit the school during school hours.
- Children may not leave school during the school day to attend extra mural activities elsewhere.
- Please do not ring the bell for early entry (before 07:30 or 12:30).
- Always close the gates behind you, please.
- Be punctual. Please make use of the playground closest to the tennis courts, if you need to wait for an extra-mural activity to finish. Please do not wait, or allow your younger children to play amongst the Aftercare learners.
- No dogs - big or small - are allowed on the school grounds.
- No smoking is allowed on school grounds.
